#### **Application for Variation – United States and Canada**

As part of a code share agreement between Qantas Airways Limited (Qantas) and WestJet Airlines Ltd (WestJet), it is proposed that WestJet will offer code share services on flights operated by Qantas on the United States and Canada routes from 1 December 2018.

A copy of the confidential code share agreement between Qantas and WestJet will be provided separately to the Commission.

#### **Variations Sought**

Qantas requests a variation to Determination 2017 [IASC] 110 to permit the utilisation of capacity for code share services with WestJet on the United States route.

Qantas requests a variation to Determination 2014 [IASC] 113 (as varied) to permit the utilisation of capacity for code share services with WestJet on the Canada route.

The variations are requested for the duration of the determinations.
