### **Application for Capacity – Cook Islands route**

From 1 July 2019, Qantas' wholly-owned subsidiary, Jetstar Airways Pty Limited (Jetstar), plans to operate two additional weekly services on the Cook Islands route.

The services will be operated using A320 aircraft configured with up to 186 seats.

### **Allocation Sought**

Qantas requests an allocation of 372 seats per week on the Cook Islands route on the following basis:

- the allocation is requested for a period of five years from the date of the determination;
- the capacity will be fully utilised by 31 October 2019;
- the capacity may be utilised by Qantas or another Australian carrier which is a wholly-owned subsidiary of Qantas; and
- the capacity may be used by Qantas to provide joint services with any wholly-owned subsidiary and by any wholly-owned subsidiary of the Qantas Group to provide joint services with Qantas.

We would be pleased to provide any further information the Commission may require in support of this application.
