**Renewal of Commission Determination – United States**

Thank you for your recent letter in relation to the renewal of Determination 2008 [IASC] 103 on the United States route which is due to expire in 2018.

Qantas continues to utilise the capacity issued by Determination 2008 [IASC] 103 on the United States route. We request renewal of this allocation of unlimited passenger and cargo capacity for a period of ten years and seek to retain the conditions set out below:

- the capacity may be utilised by Qantas or another Australian carrier which is a wholly-owned subsidiary of Qantas;
- the capacity may be used by Qantas to provide joint services with any wholly-owned subsidiary and by any wholly-owned subsidiary of the Qantas Group to provide joint services with Qantas; and
- the capacity may be used by Qantas to provide services jointly with American Airlines.

We would be pleased to provide any further information the Commission may require in considering our renewal request.
