1 The application

1.1 Qantas Airways Limited (Qantas) has applied to the Commission to revoke, pursuant to section 27AA of the *International Air Services Commission Act 1992* (the Act), Determination IASC/DET/9906 allocating passenger capacity to Qantas on the Fiji route. This determination, as amended by IASC/DEC/9930, allocates to Qantas 229 seats per week.

1.2 Qantas would retain its allocation of 50 tonnes per week of freight capacity (Determination IASC/DET/9812).

1.3 All material supplied by the applicant is filed on the Register of Public Documents.

2 Commission's consideration

2.1 If an Australian carrier asks the Commission to revoke a determination, the Commission must make a decision revoking the determination (section 27AA(3)). The Commission notes that since March 2000, Qantas has code shared with Air Pacific on the route and has not required an allocation of capacity to do so. This followed changes to the air services arrangements between Australia and Fiji which mean that an allocation of capacity is no longer required to enable an Australian carrier to code share on a designated carrier of Fiji.

3 Decision ([2000] IASC 219)

3.1 In accordance with section 27AA of the Act, the Commission revokes Determination IASC/DET/9906 allocating capacity to Qantas on the Fiji route.
