1 The application

1.1 Qantas applied to the Commission on 11 December 2003 to revoke, pursuant to section 27AA of the *International Air Services Commission Act 1992* (the Act), Determinations [2000] IASC 118, [2000] IASC 120 and [2001] IASC 120 which together allocate four frequencies on the Italy route under the Australia - Italy air services arrangements. Qantas now serves Italy with code share services on Cathay Pacific services over Hong Kong.

1.2 Material supplied by the applicant is filed on the Register of Public Documents.

2 Commission's consideration

2.1 If an Australian carrier asks the Commission to revoke a determination, the Commission must make a decision revoking the determination (section 27AA(3) of the Act).

3 Decision ([2003] IASC 217)

3.1 In accordance with section 27AA of the Act, the Commission revokes Determinations [2000] IASC 118, [2000] IASC 120 and [2001] IASC 120.
