1 The application

1.1 Qantas applied to the Commission on 13 November 2007 to revoke, pursuant to section 27AA of the *International Air Services Commission Act 1992* (the Act), Determination [2006] IASC 115 which allocates seven third-country carrier services per week under the Australia – Thailand air services arrangements. Qantas has discontinued its code share services with Finnair via Bangkok.

1.2 Material supplied by the applicant is filed on the Register of Public Documents.

2 Commission's consideration

2.1 If an Australian carrier asks the Commission to revoke a determination, the Commission must make a decision revoking the determination (section 27AA(3) of the Act).

3 Decision ([2007] IASC 224)

3.1 In accordance with section 27AA of the Act, the Commission revokes Determination [2006] IASC 115.
