#### 1 The application

1.1 Qantas applied to the Commission on 17 April 2008 to revoke, pursuant to section 27AA of the *International Air Services Commission Act 1992* (the Act), Determination [2005] IASC 110 which allocates 1,065 seats of capacity per week under the Australia – Canada air services arrangements. Qantas advised that it had discontinued its seasonal services to Canada and had no immediate plans to use the capacity.

1.2 Material supplied by the applicant is filed on the Register of Public Documents.

#### 2 Commission's consideration

2.1 If an Australian carrier asks the Commission to revoke a determination, the Commission must make a decision revoking the determination (section 27AA(3) of the Act).

#### 3 Decision ([2008] IASC 208)

3.1 In accordance with section 27AA of the Act, the Commission revokes Determination [2005] IASC 110.
