1 The application

1.1 Airnorth applied to the Commission on 24 March 2009 to revoke, pursuant to section 27AA of the *International Air Services Commission Act 1992* (the Act), Determination [2006] IASC 127 which allocates unrestricted capacity and frequency for the operation of combined passenger, cargo and mail services under the Australia – Indonesia air services arrangements. Airnorth advised that it ceased its services to Indonesia in January 2009.

1.2 Material supplied by the applicant is filed on the Register of Public Documents.

2 Commission's consideration

2.1 If an Australian carrier asks the Commission to revoke a determination, the Commission must make a decision revoking the determination (section 27AA (3) of the Act).

3 Decision ([2009] IASC 205)

3.1 In accordance with section 27AA of the Act, the Commission revokes Determination [2006] IASC 127.
