1 The application

1.1 Qantas applied to the Commission on 16 November 2000 to revoke, pursuant to section 27AA of the *International Air Services Commission Act 1992* (the Act), Determination [2000] IASC 109 allocating freight capacity to Qantas on the Indonesia route.

1.2 Qantas has been unable to secure operational approval from all parties for its planned freight services to Indonesia using wet leased aircraft. As a result, Qantas proposes to handback all freight capacity that it is unable to utilise.

1.3 All material supplied by the applicant is filed on the Register of Public Documents.

1.4 If an Australian carrier asks the Commission to revoke a determination, the Commission must make a decision revoking the determination (section 27AA(3)).

2 Decision ([2000] IASC 220)

2.1 In accordance with section 27AA of the Act, the Commission revokes Determination [2000] IASC 109 allocating two all cargo services weekly to Qantas on the Indonesia route.
