1 The application

1.1 Qantas has applied to the Commission to revoke, pursuant to section 27AA of the *International Air Services Commission Act 1992* (the Act), Determination IASC/DET/9703 which allocates capacity on the Philippines route under the Australia - Philippines air services arrangements.

1.2 Qantas, as part of its reporting to the Commission on its capacity utilisation for the Northern Winter 2001 period, advised that it no longer required the capacity allocated under the determination.

1.3 All material supplied by the applicant is filed on the Register of Public Documents.

2 Commission's consideration

2.1 If an Australian carrier asks the Commission to revoke a determination, the Commission must make a decision revoking the determination (section 27AA(3)). The effect of the revocation will be to reduce Qantas' capacity allocation on the Philippines route by 55 seats per week.

3 Decision ([2001] IASC 223)

3.1 In accordance with section 27AA of the Act, the Commission revokes Determination IASC/DET/9703 allocating capacity to Qantas on the Philippines route.
