### 1 The application

- 1.1 Qantas has applied to the Commission to revoke, pursuant to section 27AA of the *International Air Services Commission Act 1992* (the Act), Determination IASC/DET/9703 which allocates capacity on the Philippines route under the Australia Philippines air services arrangements.
- 1.2 Qantas, as part of its reporting to the Commission on its capacity utilisation for the Northern Winter 2001 period, advised that it no longer required the capacity allocated under the determination.
- 1.3 All material supplied by the applicant is filed on the Register of Public Documents.

#### 2 Commission's consideration

2.1 If an Australian carrier asks the Commission to revoke a determination, the Commission must make a decision revoking the determination (section 27AA(3)). The effect of the revocation will be to reduce Qantas' capacity allocation on the Philippines route by 55 seats per week.

## 3 Decision ([2001] IASC 223)

3.1 In accordance with section 27AA of the Act, the Commission revokes Determination IASC/DET/9703 allocating capacity to Qantas on the Philippines route.
