1 The application

1.1 Qantas applied to the Commission to revoke, pursuant to section 27AA of the *International Air Services Commission Act 1992* (the Act), Determinations [2000] IASC 101 and [2002] IASC 101 which allocate capacity on the Thailand route under the Australia - Thailand air services arrangements. Qantas, in conjunction with an application to the Commission on 8 February 2002 for other capacity on the Thailand route, advised that it no longer required the capacity allocations under the two determinations.

1.2 Material supplied by the applicant is filed on the Register of Public Documents.

2 Commission's consideration

2.1 If an Australian carrier asks the Commission to revoke a determination, the Commission must make a decision revoking the determination (section 27AA(3)). The effect of the revocations will be to remove a total of seven B747 equivalent services per week of capacity held by Qantas on the Thailand route.

3 Decision ([2002] IASC 208)

3.1 In accordance with section 27AA of the Act, the Commission revokes Determinations [2000] IASC 101 and [2002] IASC 101 allocating capacity to Qantas on the Thailand route.
