### 1 The application

1.1 Qantas applied to the Commission on 21 February 2002 to revoke, pursuant to section 27AA of the *International Air Services Commission Act 1992* (the Act), Determination IASC/DET/9823 which allocates capacity on the Switzerland route under the Australia - Switzerland air services arrangements. Qantas applied to the Commission on 8 February 2002 for an allocation of other capacity on the Switzerland route. It therefore no longer requires the 1.5 frequencies of capacity per week under Determination IASC/DET/9823.

1.2 Material supplied by the applicant is filed on the Register of Public Documents.

### 2 Commission's consideration

2.1 If an Australian carrier asks the Commission to revoke a determination, the Commission must make a decision revoking the determination (section 27AA(3)).

### 3 Decision ([2002] IASC 209)

3.1 In accordance with section 27AA of the Act, the Commission revokes Determination IASC/DET/9823 allocating capacity to Qantas on the Switzerland route.
