1 The application

1.1 Qantas applied to the Commission on 23 April 2002 to revoke, pursuant to section 27AA of the *International Air Services Commission Act 1992* (the Act), Determinations IASC/DET/9801, [2000] IASC 116 and [2001] IASC 103 which together allocate 2,100 seats per week of capacity on the India route under the Australia - India air services arrangements. Qantas withdrew its services to India at the end of March 2002.

1.2 Material supplied by the applicant is filed on the Register of Public Documents.

2 Commission's consideration

2.1 If an Australian carrier asks the Commission to revoke a determination, the Commission must make a decision revoking the determination (section 27AA(3)).

3 Decision ([2002] IASC 214)

3.1 In accordance with section 27AA of the Act, the Commission revokes Determinations IASC/DET/9801, [2000] IASC 116 and [2001] IASC 103 allocating capacity to Qantas on the India route.
