1 The application

- 1.1 Qantas advised the Commission on 23 April 2002 that it no longer required capacity allocated by Determination IASC/DET/9623 on the Solomon Islands route under the Australia Solomon Islands air services arrangements. Qantas stated that the Determination could be permitted to expire on 30 June 2002.
- 1.2 Material supplied by the applicant is filed on the Register of Public Documents.

2 Commission's consideration

2.1 The Commission notes that Qantas suspended services to Honiara in July 2000 and has advised that it no longer requires the capacity. As the capacity is not being used, the Commission will revoke the Determination now, rather than wait for its expiry.

3 Decision ([2002] IASC 215)

3.1 The Commission revokes Determination IASC/DET/9623 allocating capacity to Qantas on the Solomon Islands route.
