1 The application

1.1 Qantas applied to the Commission on 23 April 2002 to revoke, pursuant to section 27AA of the *International Air Services Commission Act 1992* (the Act), Determinations [2000] IASC 102 and [2000] IASC 119 which together allocate four B747 services per week of capacity on the Thailand route under the Australia - Thailand air services arrangements.

1.2 Material supplied by the applicant is filed on the Register of Public Documents.

2 Commission's consideration

2.1 If an Australian carrier asks the Commission to revoke a determination, the Commission must make a decision revoking the determination (section 27AA(3)).

3 Decision ([2002] IASC 216)

3.1 In accordance with section 27AA of the Act, the Commission revokes Determinations [2000] IASC 102 and [2000] IASC 119 allocating capacity to Qantas on the Thailand route.
