1 The application

1.1 Qantas applied to the Commission on 23 April 2002 to revoke, pursuant to section 27AA of the *International Air Services Commission Act 1992* (the Act), Determination [2000] IASC 104 which allocates three B767 services per week of capacity on the Vietnam route under the Australia - Vietnam air services arrangements.

1.2 Material supplied by the applicant is filed on the Register of Public Documents.

2 Commission's consideration

2.1 If an Australian carrier asks the Commission to revoke a determination, the Commission must make a decision revoking the determination (section 27AA(3)). The Commission notes that Qantas will continue to code share on Vietnam Airlines' services, but requires no capacity allocation of its own in order to do so under the air services arrangements between Australia and Vietnam.

3 Decision ([2002] IASC 217)

3.1 In accordance with section 27AA of the Act, the Commission revokes Determination [2000] IASC 104 allocating capacity to Qantas on the Vietnam route.
