## 1 The application

- 1.1 On 29 August 2002, Qantas applied to the Commission to reduce the capacity allocated by determination IASC/DET/9811 on the Vanuatu route. Qantas currently has a total allocation of 350 seats per week and is utilising 208 of those seats. Qantas stated that it does not anticipate a requirement of more than 300 seats and as a result has requested a reduction in its allocation under IASC/DET/9811 from 150 seats to 100 seats per week.
- 1.2 If an Australian carrier applies for a variation of a determination, the only effect of which would be to reduce capacity, the Commission is not required to invite submissions (section 22(1A) of the *International Air Services Commission Act 1992*) and must vary the determination as requested (section 24(3)).

## 2 Decision [2002] IASC 222

In accordance with section 24(3) of the Act, the Commission varies the allocation of capacity made to Qantas on the Vanuatu route by Determination IASC/DET/9811 from 150 seats per week to 100 seats per week.
