1 The application

- 1.1 Qantas applied to the Commission on 11 December 2003 to revoke, pursuant to section 27AA of the *International Air Services Commission Act 1992* (the Act), Determinations [2002] IASC 119 and [2003] IASC 101 which each allocate one all-cargo service on the Thailand route under the Australia Thailand air services arrangements.
- 1.2 Material supplied by the applicant is filed on the Register of Public Documents.

2 Commission's consideration

2.1 If an Australian carrier asks the Commission to revoke a determination, the Commission must make a decision revoking the determination (section 27AA(3) of the Act).
