1 The application

1.1 Qantas applied to the Commission on 11 December 2003 to revoke, pursuant to section 27AA of the *International Air Services Commission Act 1992* (the Act), Determination IASC/DET/9912 which allocates 888 seats per week on the Taiwan route under the Australia - Taiwan air services arrangements. Qantas now serves Taiwan on code share services with Eva Air.

1.2 Material supplied by the applicant is filed on the Register of Public Documents.

2 Commission's consideration

2.1 If an Australian carrier asks the Commission to revoke a determination, the Commission must make a decision revoking the determination (section 27AA(3) of the Act).

3 Decision ([2003] IASC 218)

3.1 In accordance with section 27AA of the Act, the Commission revokes Determination IASC/DET/9912.
