#### 1 The application

1.1 Qantas applied to the Commission on 22 July 2004 to revoke, pursuant to section 27AA of the *International Air Services Commission Act 1992* (the Act), Determination [2002] IASC 125 which allocates 50 tonnes per week of freight capacity under the Australia - Fiji air services arrangements. Qantas stated that while it did not currently require the capacity it may do so in 2005, in that event it would submit a new application.

1.2 Material supplied by the applicant is filed on the Register of Public Documents.

#### 2 Delegate's consideration

2.1 In accordance with section 27AB of the Act and regulation 3A of the *International Air Services Commission Amendment Regulations 2003 (No.1)*, the delegate of the Commission considers the Qantas application.

2.2 If an Australian carrier asks the Commission to revoke a determination, the Commission must make a decision revoking the determination (section 27AA(3) of the Act).

#### 3 Decision ([2004] IASC 204)

3.1 In accordance with section 27AA of the Act, the delegate, on behalf of the Commission, revokes Determination [2002] IASC 125.
