## **DECISION**

Decision: [2004] IASC 212 Revocation of: [2003] IASC 106

## 1 The application

- 1.1 Qantas applied to the Commission on 27 September 2004 to revoke, pursuant to section 27AA of the *International Air Services Commission Act 1992* (the Act), Determination [2003] IASC 106 which allocates three units per week under the Australia France air services arrangements. Qantas requested that the revocation take effect after 31 October 2004, when it proposes to introduce code share services with Air France between Australia and France.
- 1.2 Material supplied by the applicant is filed on the Register of Public Documents.

# 2 Delegate's consideration

- 2.1 In accordance with section 27AB of the *International Air Services Commission Act 1992* (the Act) and regulation 3A of the *International Air Services Commission Amendment Regulations 2003 (No.1)*, the delegate of the Commission considers the Qantas application.
- 2.2 If an Australian carrier asks the Commission to revoke a determination, the Commission must make a decision revoking the determination (section 27AA(3) of the Act).

# 3 Decision ([2004] IASC 212)

3.1 In accordance with section 27AA of the Act, the delegate, on behalf of the Commission, revokes Determinations [2003] IASC 106.
