1 The application

1.1 Qantas applied to the Commission on 3 December 2004 to revoke, pursuant to section 27AA of the *International Air Services Commission Act 1992* (the Act), Determinations [2001] IASC 115 and [2004] IASC 111 which each allocate one all cargo service per week under the Australia - Netherlands air services arrangements.

1.2 Material supplied by the applicant is filed on the Register of Public Documents.

2 Delegate's consideration

2.1 In accordance with section 27AB of the *International Air Services Commission Act 1992* (the Act) and regulation 3A of the *International Air Services Commission Amendment Regulations 2003 (No.1)*, the delegate of the Commission considers the Qantas application.

2.2 If an Australian carrier asks the Commission to revoke a determination, the Commission must make a decision revoking the determination (section 27AA(3) of the Act).

3 Decision ([2004] IASC 215)

3.1 In accordance with section 27AA of the Act, the delegate, on behalf of the Commission, revokes Determinations [2001] IASC 115 and [2004] IASC 111.
