## 1 The application

- 1.1 Qantas applied to the Commission on 4 May 2006 to revoke, pursuant to section 27AA of the *International Air Services Commission Act 1992* (the Act), Determination [2005] IASC 113, which allocates 18 northbound and 11 southbound third-country code share services per week on the Thailand route.
- 1.2 Material supplied by the applicant is filed on the Register of Public Documents.

## 2 Delegate's consideration

- 2.1 In accordance with section 27AB of the Act and regulation 3A of the *International Air Services Commission Amendment Regulations 2003 (No.1)*, the delegate of the Commission considers the Qantas application.
- 2.2 If an Australian carrier asks the Commission to revoke a determination, the Commission must make a decision revoking the determination (section 27AA(3) of the Act).

# 3 Decision [2006] IASC 212

3.1 In accordance with section 27AA of the Act, the delegate, on behalf of the Commission revokes Determination [2005] IASC 113.
