1 The application

- 1.1 Pacific Air Express applied to the Commission on 16 May 2006 for revocation of Determination [2003] IASC 117, which allocates 12.5 tonnes of freight capacity per week on the PNG route.
- 1.2 Material supplied by the applicant is filed on the Register of Public Documents.

2 Delegate's consideration

- 2.1 In accordance with section 27AB of the *International Air Services Commission Act 1992* (the Act) and regulation 3A of the *International Air Services Commission Amendment Regulations 2003* (*No.1*), the delegate of the Commission considers the Pacific Air Express application.
- 2.2 If an Australian carrier asks the Commission to revoke a determination, the Commission must make a decision revoking the determination (section 27AA(3) of the Act). In making the decision, the delegate notes that a proposed Commission review of Pacific Air Express' determination, advertised on 17 May 2006, is superseded by this decision.

3 Decision [2006] IASC 214

3.1 In accordance with section 27AA of the Act, the delegate, on behalf of the Commission, revokes Determination [2003] IASC 123.
