1 The application

1.1 Qantas applied to the Commission on 10 August 2006 to revoke, pursuant to section 27AA of the *International Air Services Commission Act 1992* (the Act), several determinations which together allocate 28 services per week of capacity on the United Kingdom route. The determinations to be revoked and the amount of capacity allocated by each are as follows:

- [2001] IASC 124 - 14 services per week
- [2002] IASC 103 - four services per week
- [2002] IASC 120 - three services per week
- [2004] IASC 102 - four services per week
- [2004] IASC 112 - three services per week.

1.2 The Commission published a notice on 16 August 2006 inviting submissions about the application. No submissions were received. All material supplied by the applicant is filed on the Register of Public Documents.

1.3 Concurrently with the application for the revocations, Qantas applied for a new allocation of unlimited capacity and frequency on the UK route - see Determination [2006] IASC 105.

1.4 If an Australian carrier asks the Commission to revoke a determination, the Commission must make a decision revoking the determination (section 27AA(3) of the Act). The Commission will revoke the determinations as requested by Qantas.
