#### 1 The application

1.1 Qantas applied to the Commission on 13 November 2007 to reduce the capacity allocated by Determination [2004] IASC 104 on the India route by 925 seats per week, from 2,100 seats per week to 1,175 seats per week. Material supplied by the applicant is filed on the Register of Public Documents.

#### 2 Commission's consideration

2.1 If an Australian carrier applies for a variation of a determination, the only effect of which would be to reduce capacity, the Commission is not required to invite submissions (section 22(1A) of the *International Air Services Commission Act 1992*) and must vary the determination as requested in the application (section 24(3)).

#### 3 Decision ([2007] IASC 217)

3.1 In accordance with section 24(3) of the Act, the Commission varies the allocation of capacity made to Qantas on the India route under Determination [2004] IASC 104 (the Determination) by:

*removing* the following from paragraph 8.1 of the Determination:

- “allocating 2,100 seats of capacity per week in each direction”

*and replacing* the deletion from paragraph 8.1 of the Determination with

- “allocating 1,175 seats of capacity per week in each direction”
