Decision: [2007] IASC 218 Revocation of: [2005] IASC 112

The Route: India

The Applicant: Qantas Airways Limited

1 The application

- 1.1 Qantas applied to the Commission on 13 November 2007 to revoke, pursuant to section 27AA of the *International Air Services Commission Act 1992* (the Act), Determination [2005] IASC 112 which allocates 300 third-country code share seats per week under the Australia India air services arrangements. Qantas advised that Jetstar Asia no longer operates services between Singapore and Kolkata on which Qantas had code shared. Accordingly, there is no immediate prospect of Qantas using the code share capacity.
- 1.2 Material supplied by the applicant is filed on the Register of Public Documents.

2 Commission's consideration

2.1 If an Australian carrier asks the Commission to revoke a determination, the Commission must make a decision revoking the determination (section 27AA(3) of the Act).

3 Decision ([2007] IASC 218)

3.1 In accordance with section 27AA of the Act, the Commission revokes Determination [2005] IASC 112.
