1 The application

1.1 Qantas applied to the Commission on 13 November 2007 to revoke, pursuant to section 27AA of the *International Air Services Commission Act 1992* (the Act), Determination [2004] IASC 107 which allocates unlimited freight capacity under the Australia - Taiwan air services arrangements. Qantas is not operating on the route.

1.2 Material supplied by the applicant is filed on the Register of Public Documents.

2 Commission's consideration

2.1 If an Australian carrier asks the Commission to revoke a determination, the Commission must make a decision revoking the determination (section 27AA(3) of the Act).

3.1 In accordance with section 27AA of the Act, the Commission revokes Determination [2004] IASC 107.
