1 The application

1.1 HeavyLift applied to the Commission on 29 April 2008 to revoke, pursuant to section 27AA of the *International Air Services Commission Act 1992* (the Act), Determination [2005] IASC 104. This determination allocates unlimited freight capacity and frequency on the China route under the Australia – China air services arrangements.

1.2 Material supplied by the applicant is filed on the Register of Public Documents.

2 Commission's consideration

2.1 If an Australian carrier asks the Commission to revoke a determination, the Commission must make a decision revoking the determination (section 27AA(3) of the Act).

3 Decision ([2008] IASC 205)

3.1 In accordance with section 27AA of the Act, the Commission revokes Determination [2005] IASC 104.
