# 1 The application

- 1.1 Qantas applied to the Commission on 17 November 2008 to revoke, pursuant to section 27AA of the *International Air Services Commission Act 1992* (the Act), Determination [2007] IASC 101 which allocates 909 seats per week on the Malaysia route. Qantas' wholly-owned subsidiary, Jetstar, withdrew from the route in June 2008 and Qantas has sought the revocation of its capacity allocation on the route.
- 1.2 Material supplied by the applicant is filed on the Register of Public Documents.

#### 2 Commission's consideration

2.1 If an Australian carrier asks the Commission to revoke a determination, the Commission must make a decision revoking the determination (section 27AA (3) of the Act).

## **Decision ([2008] IASC 222)**

3.1 In accordance with section 27AA of the Act, the Commission revokes Determination [2007] IASC 101.
