1 The application

1.1 Qantas applied to the Commission on 24 March 2009 to revoke, pursuant to section 27AA of the *International Air Services Commission Act 1992* (the Act), Determination [2007] IASC 103 which allocates 835 seats of capacity per week under the Australia – China air services arrangements. Qantas advised that it had rationalised its services to China and would now only operate a daily service to Shanghai using Airbus A330-300 aircraft. Other determinations held by Qantas allocate sufficient capacity for these services.

1.2 Material supplied by the applicant is filed on the Register of Public Documents.

2 Commission's consideration

2.1 If an Australian carrier asks the Commission to revoke a determination, the Commission must make a decision revoking the determination (section 27AA (3) of the Act).

3 Decision ([2009] IASC 203)

3.1 In accordance with section 27AA of the Act, the Commission revokes Determination [2007] IASC 103.
