1 The application

- 1.1 Airnorth applied to the Commission on 24 March 2009 to revoke, pursuant to section 27AA of the *International Air Services Commission Act 1992* (the Act), Determination [2006] IASC 127 which allocates unrestricted capacity and frequency for the operation of combined passenger, cargo and mail services under the Australia Indonesia air services arrangements. Airnorth advised that it ceased its services to Indonesia in January 2009.
- 1.2 Material supplied by the applicant is filed on the Register of Public Documents.

2 Commission's consideration

2.1 If an Australian carrier asks the Commission to revoke a determination, the Commission must make a decision revoking the determination (section 27AA (3) of the Act).

3 Decision ([2009] IASC 205)

3.1 In accordance with section 27AA of the Act, the Commission revokes Determination [2006] IASC 127.
