1 The application

1.1 The liquidators for Sky Air World applied to the Commission on 18 June 2009 to revoke, pursuant to section 27AA of the *International Air Services Commission Act 1992* (the Act), determinations held by the airline. Determination [2007] IASC 121 allocates 470 seats per week of capacity on the Solomon Islands route. Determination [2009] IASC 102 allocates unrestricted passenger capacity on the Indonesia route between points in Australia, except Sydney, Melbourne, Brisbane and Perth and authorised points in Indonesia. A third determination referred to by the liquidators related to another carrier and is not held by Sky Air World.

1.2 Material supplied by the applicant is filed on the Register of Public Documents.

2 Delegate's consideration

2.1 In accordance with section 27AB of the Act and regulation 3A of the *International Air Services Commission Regulations 1992*, the delegate of the Commission considers the Sky Air World (In Liquidation) application.

2.2 If an Australian carrier asks the Commission to revoke a determination, the Commission must make a decision revoking the determination (section 27AA(3) of the Act).

3 Decision ([2009] IASC 207)

3.1 In accordance with section 27AA of the Act, the delegate, on behalf of the Commission revokes Determination [2007] IASC 121.

4 Decision ([2009] IASC 208)

4.1 In accordance with section 27AA of the Act, the delegate, on behalf of the Commission, revokes Determination [2009] IASC 102.
