1 The application

- 1.1 Qantas applied to the Commission on 10 September 2010 to revoke, pursuant to section 27AA of the *International Air Services Commission Act 1992* (the Act), Determinations [2006] IASC 102 and [2008] IASC 108 which allocate three frequencies per week and two frequencies per week respectively on the Vietnam route. Qantas advised that, following a review of the Group's plans for the Vietnam route, there are is no immediate intention to operate direct services between Australia's gateway points and Vietnam.
- 1.2 Material supplied by the applicant is filed on the Register of Public Documents.

2 Delegate's consideration

- 2.1 In accordance with section 27AB of the Act and regulation 3A of the *International Air Services Commission Amendment Regulations 2003 (No.1)*, the delegate of the Commission considers the Qantas application.
- 2.2 If an Australian carrier asks the Commission to revoke a determination, the Commission must make a decision revoking the determination (section 27AA (3) of the Act).

3.1 In accordance with section 27AA of the Act the delegate, on behalf of the Commission, revokes Determinations [2006] IASC 102 and [2008] IASC 108.
