Decision: Revocation of: The Route: The Applicant: [2011] IASC 203 [2009] IASC 112 and [2009] IASC 116 France – Route 3 (New Caledonia) Pacific Wings Pty Ltd (ACN 136 119 947) (Pacific Wings) IASC/APP/201102

1 The application

1.1 Pacific Wings applied to the Commission on 3 March 2011 to revoke, pursuant to section 27AA of the *International Air Services Commission Act 1992* (the Act), Determinations [2009] IASC 112 and [2009] IASC 116 which allocated respectively 0.25 and 0.5 units of capacity per week on the Australia – France Route 3 (New Caledonia) route under the Australia – France air services arrangements. Pacific Wings advised that an ongoing operational impediment had prevented it from launching its services as anticipated.

1.2 Material supplied by the applicant is filed on the Register of Public Documents.

2 Delegate's consideration

2.1 In accordance with section 27AB of the Act and regulation 3A of the *International Air Services Commission Amendment Regulations 2003 (No.1)*, the delegate of the Commission considers the Pacific Wings application.

2.2 If an Australian carrier asks the Commission to revoke a determination, the Commission must make a decision revoking the determination (section 27AA (3) of the Act).

3 Decision ([2011] IASC 203)

3.1 In accordance with section 27AA of the Act the delegate, on behalf of the Commission, revokes Determinations [2009] IASC 112 and [2009] IASC 116.
