#### 1 The application

1.1 Qantas applied to the Commission on 26 May 2011 to revoke, pursuant to section 27AA of the *International Air Services Commission Act 1992* (the Act), Determination [2009] IASC 122 and [2007] IASC 115 which allocated respectively 2 frequencies and 4 frequencies of capacity per week on the Australia – Hong Kong route under the Australia – Hong Kong air services arrangements.

1.2 Material supplied by the applicant is filed on the Register of Public Documents.

#### 2 Delegate's consideration

2.1 In accordance with section 27AB of the Act and regulation 3A of the *International Air Services Commission Amendment Regulations 2003 (No.1)*, the delegate of the Commission will consider the Qantas application.

2.2 If an Australian carrier asks the Commission to revoke a determination, the Commission must make a decision revoking the determination (section 27AA (3) of the Act).

#### 3 Decision ([2011] IASC 211)

3.1 In accordance with section 27AA of the Act the delegate, on behalf of the Commission, revokes Determinations [2009] IASC 122 and [2007] IASC 115.
