1 The application

1.1 Qantas applied to the Commission on 13 March 2012 to revoke, pursuant to section 27AA of the *International Air Services Commission Act 1992* (the Act), Determination [2004] IASC 124 which allocates unlimited capacity and frequency for dedicated cargo services under the Australia – India air services arrangements.

1.2 Material supplied by the applicant is filed on the Register of Public Documents.

2 Delegate's consideration

2.1 In accordance with section 27AB of the Act and regulation 3A of the *International Air Services Commission Regulations 1992*, the delegate of the Commission considers the Qantas application.

2.2 If an Australian carrier asks the Commission to revoke a determination, the Commission must make a decision revoking the determination (section 27AA(3) of the Act).

3 Decision ([2012] IASC 207)

3.1 In accordance with section 27AA of the Act the delegate, on behalf of the Commission, revokes Determination [2004] IASC 124.
