[2010] IASC 115; and [2012] IASC 103

1 The application

1.1 Qantas applied to the Commission on 29 November 2012 to revoke, pursuant to section 27AA of the *International Air Services Commission Act 1992* (the Act), the following determinations:

- [2008] IASC 105 (valid until 20 October 2013);
- [2008] IASC 109 (valid until 16 July 2013);
- [2009] IASC 126 (valid until 27 July 2015);
- [2010] IASC 115 (valid until 26 September 2016); and
- [2012] IASC 103 (valid until 30 June 2017).

These determinations together allocate seven frequencies per week under the Australia – South Africa air services arrangements.

1.2 Material supplied by the applicant is filed on the Register of Public Documents available on the Commission's website (www.iasc.gov.au).

2 Commission's consideration

2.1 Subsection 27AA(1) of the Act allows an Australian carrier, to whom a determination allocating capacity is given, to request the Commission, at any time, to revoke the determination.

2.2 If an Australian carrier asks the Commission to revoke a determination, the Commission must make a decision revoking the determination (section 27AA(3) of the Act).

3 Decision ([2012] IASC 223)

3.1 In accordance with section 27AA of the Act, the Commission revokes determinations [2008] IASC 105, [2008] IASC 109, [2009] IASC 126, [2010] IASC 115, and [2012] IASC 103, with effect from the date this decision is made.

3.2 It is noted that paragraph 10.2 of Determination [2012] IASC 106 provides that Determination [2012] IASC 106 is valid for a period of five years from the date that Qantas' existing determinations on the South Africa route (namely, [2008] IASC 105, [2008] IASC 109, [2009] IASC 126, [2010] IASC 115, and [2012] IASC 103) are revoked.


