### 1 The application

1.1 Qantas applied to the Commission on 19 November 2012 to revoke, pursuant to section 27AA of the *International Air Services Commission Act 1992* (the Act), Determination [2008] IASC 122 which allocates 1,175 seats per week under the Australia - India air services arrangements.

#### 2 Commission's consideration

- 2.1 Subsection 27AA(1) of the Act allows an Australian carrier, to whom a determination allocating capacity is given, to request the Commission, at any time, to revoke the determination.
- 2.2 If an Australian carrier asks the Commission to revoke a determination, subsection 27AA(3) of the Act requires the Commission to make a decision revoking the determination.

# 3 Decision ([2013] IASC 210)

3.1 In accordance with section 27AA of the Act the Commission, revokes Determination [2008] IASC 122.
