

[2013] IASC R01 (23 January 2013) Virgin Australia International Airlines Pty Ltd

Determination [2010] IASC 122 (the Determination) allocates to V Australia, now known as Virgin Australia International Airlines Pty Ltd (Virgin Australia), five frequencies per week of capacity on the Bangladesh route.

The Determination was varied by Decision [2012] IASC 211 which added certain conditions including requiring Virgin Australia to fully utilise the capacity from no later than 27 October 2012, or from such other date approved by the Commission.

On 5 November 2012, Virgin Australia applied to the Commission to extend the date of utilisation of the capacity to 24 March 2013 on the basis that Virgin Australia's application to the Bangladesh Civil Aviation Authority for approval to implement the services is still under consideration.

In view of the above, the Commission resolves ([2013] IASC R01) to grant an extension of time for the utilisation of capacity on the Bangladesh route. Virgin Australia must fully utilise the capacity allocated on the Bangladesh route pursuant to Determination [2010] IASC 122, as varied by Decision [2012] IASC 211, by 24 March 2013 or such later date as determined by the Commission.
