Renewal of Commission Determination - Singapore

Thank you for your letter of 16 March 2017 in relation to the renewal of Determination 2013 [IASC] 120 on the Singapore route which is due to expire in 2018.

Qantas requests renewal of Determination 2013 [IASC] 120, as amended by [2014] IASC 231, which allocates 300 seats per week in each direction on the Singapore route, and we seek to retain the existing conditions set out below:

- the capacity may be utilised by Qantas or another Australian carrier which is a wholly-owned subsidiary of Qantas;
- the capacity may be used by Qantas to provide joint services with any wholly-owned subsidiary and by any wholly-owned subsidiary of the Qantas Group to provide joint services with Qantas;
- the capacity may be used by Qantas to provide services jointly with Emirates; and
- the capacity may be used by Qantas to provide services jointly with SriLankan Airlines.

We would be pleased to provide any further information the Commission may require in considering our renewal request.
