**Re: Renewal of Commission Determinations**

Thank you for your recent letter which invited Qantas to express its interest in the renewal of determinations due to expire within the next 12 months.

**China route - Determination [2007] IASC 110**

Qantas continues to operate dedicated freighter services to China under Determination [2007] IASC 110, which allocates unlimited capacity for all-cargo services on the China route. We therefore request renewal of this allocation of capacity for a period of ten years from 24 October 2018.

**Singapore route – Determination [2007] IASC 116**

Qantas continues to operate services to Singapore utilising capacity allocated under Determination [2007] IASC 116, as varied, which allocates unlimited capacity and frequency on the Singapore route. We therefore request renewal of this Determination for a period of ten years from 31 October 2018.

As part of the renewal, Qantas requests the following conditions be retained:

- the capacity may be utilised by Qantas or another Australian carrier which is a wholly-owned subsidiary of Qantas;
- the capacity may be used by Qantas to provide joint services with any wholly-owned subsidiary and by any wholly owned subsidiary of the Qantas Group to provide joint services with Qantas;
- the capacity may be used by Qantas to provide services jointly with Emirates, Finnair, British Airways, China Eastern, Japan Airlines, Jet Airways, Bangkok Airways, Sri Lankan Airlines, Fiji Airways and LATAM; and
- the capacity may be used by Jetstar to provide services jointly with Emirates and Finnair.




**Indonesia route - Determination [2013] IASC 115**

Qantas continues to utilise the capacity allocated by Determination 2013 [IASC] 115 (as varied by Decision [2014] 223). We request renewal of this Determination, including all current conditions, for a period of five years from 25 October 2018.
