Revocation of IASC Determination 123/2007 – Papua New Guinea Route

On 10 December 2007, the Commission issued Determination 123/2007 allocating Qantas 34 tonnes of freight capacity per week in each direction on the Australia – Papua New Guinea route to support twice weekly B737-300 freighter aircraft.

The allocation was subsequently varied by Decision 204/2009 to 17.5 tonnes when Qantas' wholly-owned subsidiary company Express Freighters Australia Pty Limited (EFA) had planned to commence a weekly service on the route during the Northern Winter 2009 scheduling period.

However, after a review of scheduling plans, EFA does not plan to operate services between points in Australia and Port Moresby in the immediate future.

We therefore seek revocation of Determination 123/2007.
