## Application for Capacity Allocation - Indonesia

Pacific Blue Airlines (Aust) seeks a Determination which would permit it to operate an additional 13 weekly services between points in Australia and Indonesia. Pacific Blue would operate these services utilising 180 seat B737-800 aircraft.

## Allocation Sought

Pacific Blue requests an allocation of an additional 2,340 seats each way each week on the Indonesia route on the following basis:
