Application for Variation - Singapore

From 26 October 2014, Qantas and SriLankan Airlines plan to code share on the Singapore route, whereby:

- SriLankan Airlines intends to code share on selected flights operated by Qantas between Singapore and Australia; and
- Qantas intends to code share on selected flights operated by SriLankan Airlines between Singapore and Colombo, Sri Lanka.

A copy of the confidential code share agreement between Qantas and SriLankan Airlines has been provided separately to the Commission.

Variations Sought

Qantas seeks a variation to the following determinations to add conditions permitting joint services between Qantas and SriLankan Airlines:

- Singapore Determination [2007] IASC 116 (as varied) allocating unlimited capacity and frequency; and
- Singapore Determination [2013] IASC 120 allocating 300 seats per week between Singapore and Colombo.

The variations are requested for the duration of the determinations.
