Instrument of Delegation

We, Jill Walker, Stephen Bartos and Ian Douglas, Commissioners of the International Air Services Commission, pursuant to the power given to the Commission by section 27AB of the *International Air Services Commission Act 1992* (the Act) and regulation 3A of the International Air Services Commission Regulations 1992, hereby delegate the following powers to the Executive Director, International Air Services Commission, or in his or her absence, to the Senior Adviser, International Air Services Commission:

1. make a decision revoking a determination under subsection 27AA(3); and

2. make copies of the decision available to the public and publish a notice under subsection 27AA(4) of the Act.

The powers delegated in this instrument are in addition to the powers delegated by the Instrument of Delegation dated 6 November 2012.

Instrument of Delegation

We, Jill Walker and Stephen Bartos, Commissioners of the International Air Services Commission, pursuant to the power given to the Commission by section 27AB of the *International Air Services Commission Act 1992* (the Act) and regulation 3A of the International Air Services Commission Regulations 1992, hereby delegate the following powers to the Executive Director, International Air Services Commission, or in his or her absence, to the Senior Adviser, International Air Services Commission:

- 1. to make a determination allocating available capacity under section 7 of the Act, if no more than one application is made for the capacity;
- 2. to make a fresh determination allocating capacity under section 8 of the Act;
- 3. to invite, by notice, in accordance with section 12 of the Act:
 - applications for a determination allocating the capacity; and
 - submissions about the allocation of the capacity;
- 4. to consider the renewal of a determination (other than an interim determination) under subsection 17(1) of the Act.

In addition, if an Australian carrier applies under section 21 of the Act for a variation of a determination to allocate capacity under subsection 10(2) of the Act, then providing no submission is received objecting to the allocation or if we consider it unlikely that no objection will be made, we delegate the following powers:

- 5. to conduct a review of a determination under subsection 10(2) of the Act; and
- 6. to vary a determination as requested in the application.
