RE: Renewal of Determinations

Qantas Airways Limited (Qantas) appreciates the opportunity to express its interest in the renewal of the following determinations allocating capacity to Qantas which will expire in the next 12 months.

[2015] IASC 113 – Cook Islands route

Qantas' wholly owned subsidiary, Jetstar Airways Pty Limited, continues to utilise the capacity allocated under this Determination in operating services to the Cook Islands. We request renewal of this Determination, including all conditions, for a period of five years from 22 October 2020.

[2015] IASC 111 – Singapore route

Qantas continues to utilise the capacity allocated under this Determination to exercise own stopover rights between Singapore and Colombo. We request renewal of this Determination on the following basis:

- The allocation is requested for a period of five years from 22 October 2020;
- The capacity may be utilised by Qantas or Jetstar Airways Pty Limited, as long as it remains a wholly owned subsidiary of Qantas or such other wholly owned subsidiary of Qantas that the Commission approves in writing, as long as it remains a wholly-owned subsidiary of Qantas; and
- The capacity may be used by Qantas to provide services jointly with SriLankan Airlines.

We would be pleased to provide any further information the Commission may require.
