Application for Capacity – Korea route

From 31 March 2019, it is proposed that Qantas will offer code share services on flights operated by Cathay Pacific Airways Limited (Cathay Pacific) and Hong Kong Dragon Airlines Limited (Cathay Dragon) on the Korea route.

A copy of the confidential code share agreements between Qantas and Cathay Pacific and Qantas and Cathay Dragon will be provided separately to the Commission.

Allocation Sought

Qantas requests an allocation of 400 seats per week on the Korea route on the following basis:

- the allocation is for a period of five years from the date of the determination;
- the capacity will be fully used by 27 October 2019; and
- the capacity may be utilised by Qantas.

It is requested that the capacity may be used by Qantas to provide services jointly with Cathay Pacific.

It is requested that the capacity may be used by Qantas to provide services jointly with Cathay Dragon.

We would be pleased to provide any further information the Commission may require.
