Application for Capacity – Indonesia route

Effective during the Northern Winter scheduling season, commencing 28 October 2018, Qantas plans to upgrade aircraft on selected services on the Indonesia route, including from B737 to A330 aircraft.

For flexibility, the ability for another Australian carrier which is a wholly-owned subsidiary of Qantas, such as Jetstar Airways Pty Limited, to utilise capacity on the route is requested.

Allocation Sought

Qantas requests an allocation of 1,250 seats per week on the Indonesia route on the following basis:

- the allocation is requested for a period of five years from the date of the determination;
- the capacity will be fully utilised by 31 January 2019;
- the capacity may be utilised by Qantas or another Australian carrier which is a wholly-owned subsidiary of Qantas;
- the capacity may be used to by Qantas to provide joint services with any wholly-owned subsidiary and by any wholly-owned subsidiary of the Qantas Group to provide joint services with Qantas; and
- the capacity may be used by Jetstar to provide services jointly with Emirates.

We would be pleased to provide any further information the Commission may require in support of this application.
